## **Planet Budapest 2021 „A green step closer” – Student project contest 2021**

The Embassy of Hungary in Jakarta announces the „A green step closer” – Student project contest 2021 in order to promote the [Planet Budapest 2021 Sustainability Expo and Summit](#). During the competition, participants will be required to prepare a concept and presentation on how would they use sustainable technologies in Indonesia. The 'A green step closer' challenge on one hand refers to taking the next step towards sustainability and on the other hand to bring Hungary and Indonesia 'one green step closer'.

### **The project**

We are looking for participants from the Indonesian universities, who will develop a specific concept in the framework of a presentation/concept paper using a Hungarian green technology of their choice in Indonesia.

### **Participation**

Participation is open to undergraduate (BSc) and graduate (MSc) students of any university in the Republic of Indonesia regardless of the curriculum in team of one.

The deadline for submitting the project is 5 November 2021 (WIB 11:59 PM). To participate you must upload your:

- Filled application form (find the link below)
- Min. 2, max. 5 pages project concept
- Power Point presentation in max. 10 slides introducing briefly the concept (presentation time 10 minutes)

## **Prize**

There are three prizes for the best project concepts. The committee retains the right to make decisions as they see best.

**3<sup>rd</sup> prize:** a package of environmental friendly products with the logo of Planet Budapest 2021 (metal straws, metal bottles, vouchers for bulk shops, etc.)

**2<sup>nd</sup> prize:** a dinner with the Ambassador of Hungary in Jakarta

**1<sup>st</sup> prize:** a trip to Budapest for Planet Budapest 2021, including the plane ticket, accommodation and entry ticket to the expo for one (1) person (expected travelling time: 28 November 2021 – 6 December 2021)

## **What are the judges looking for?**

- *The story:* Your content includes the environmental problem in a specific city or region in Indonesia you were looking to solve, your approach, your learnings and the overall outcome. You are answering questions like why did you choose that exact Hungarian company and how its' technology could solve the environmental problem, and how it can be implemented.
- *Media:* Your content includes a variety of media to support the written text. i.e. video links, photos, link to articles as references (e.g. about a heavily polluted area that needs to be cleaned).
- *Audience engagement:* Your content captures the interest of the audience, is interesting and easy to read and digest.

## **Evaluation and announcement of the winners**

- Applications are reviewed and five (5) students are selected to present their project via video call on 10 November 2021. The topic of the project is unlimited but must be technical in nature. Students are assigned 10-minute sessions to present their concept and conclusions. Participants are judged on overall knowledge of project topic, thoroughness of the content, and presentation skills.
- Due to the pandemic situation, there will be no physical evaluation of the projects, and the winners will be announced virtually by 15 November 2021 at the latest.

## **Eligibility Requirements and Competition Guidelines**

- Participants must be at least 18 years of age as of the date of entering the contest.
- Participants must be enrolled on a full or part-time university-level programme in the Republic of Indonesia.
- Entries must be supplied as published at the Hunindotech.id website prior to the closing date of the competition.
- All entries must be supplied in English language and comply with the Embassy of Hungary in Jakarta guidelines to pass moderation and be considered completed entries eligible for the competition.
- Submission period of the project: 25 October – 5 November 2021 (WIB 11.59 PM)
- Presentation date for the pre-qualified projects: 10 November 2021 (via video call)
- Expected travelling time: 28 November – 6 December 2021 (departure from Jakarta: 28 November 2021, departure back to Jakarta from Budapest 5 December 2021)
- For the winner, the costs of the return flight ticket, visa, and accommodation in Budapest will be borne by the Embassy of Hungary. Catering will be provided during the Planet Budapest Summit (30 November – 2 December 2021), at the location of the event.

- For the winner, the Embassy of Hungary may organize additional activities on the sidelines of Planet Budapest 2021 Sustainability Expo and Summit (e.g. a coffee break with the event's organizing committee, a meetup with Indonesian students studying in Hungary, etc.)
- Participants of the contest must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 and must hold a passport that is valid for at least 6 months.
- Participants must be aware of the prevailing entry requirements upon returning to Indonesia (e.g. PCR test prior to return, mandatory quarantine, etc.), as stipulated by the Indonesian authorities.
